<p>Consolidate Autumn list</p> <p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <p><u>Fiction</u></p> <p>Secure independent use of planning tools</p> <p>Story mountain/ grids/ flow diagrams</p> <p>Plan opening using:</p> <p>Description/ action/ dialogue</p> <p><b>Paragraphs</b></p> <p><b>Vary connectives within paragraphs to build cohesion into a paragraph.</b></p> <p><b>Use change of place, time and action to link ideas across paragraphs.</b></p> <p>Use 5 part story structure</p> <p>Writing could start at any of the 5 points.</p> <p>This may include flashbacks</p> <p>Introduction – should include action / description – character or setting / dialogue</p> <p>Build Up – develop suspense techniques</p> <p>Problem / Dilemma / Event – may be more than one problem to be resolved</p> <p>Resolution – clear links with dilemma</p> <p>Ending – character could reflect on events, any changes or lessons, look forward to future ask a question</p>	<p>Consolidate Autumn list</p> <p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <p>Develop complex sentences: subordination</p> <p>Main and subordinate clauses with a full range of conjunctions.</p> <p>Elaboration of starters using adverbial phrases e.g. <i>Beyond the dark gloom of the cave, Zach saw the wizard move.</i></p> <p>Moving sentence chunks (how,when,where) around for different effects e.g. <i>The siren echoed loudly...through the lonely streets...at midnight</i></p>	<p>Consolidate Autumn list</p> <p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <p>Developed use of technical language</p> <p>Converting nouns or adjectives into verbs using suffixes e.g. <i>-ate, -ise, -ify</i></p>	<p>Consolidate Autumn list</p> <p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <p>Colons</p> <p>Use of commas to clarify meaning or avoid ambiguity</p>	<p>Consolidate Autumn spellings</p> <p>Words ending in –able e.g. <i>considerable</i></p> <p>Words ending in –ible e.g. <i>possible, incredible</i></p> <p>words with the I sound spelt ei after c e.g. <i>receive, ceiling</i></p> <p>Words containing the letter sting ough e.g. <i>bought, fought</i></p>
