


#### Handwriting Practise:

Over the next couple of weeks, we will be building up to write a story including 5 parts. The introduction, the build-up, the middle, the resolution and finally the ending.




# Addition:

Remember when you add you need to count 2 groups to find out how many there are altogether.




Use First, Then, Now to discuss your addition story or you could add on using the number line method.

Ron and Mo are working out 3 + 11 on a number line.






