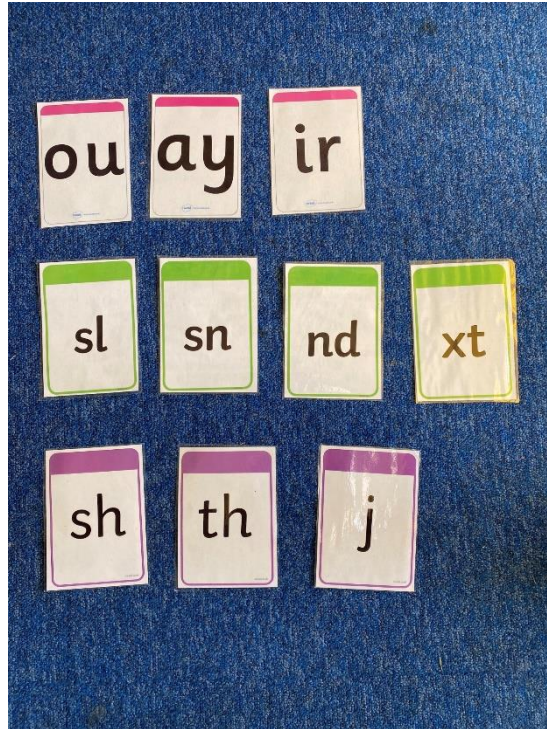

Please watch the video and practise your handwriting. I would like you to start the week using your neatest handwriting. Remember how important those tall letters are.

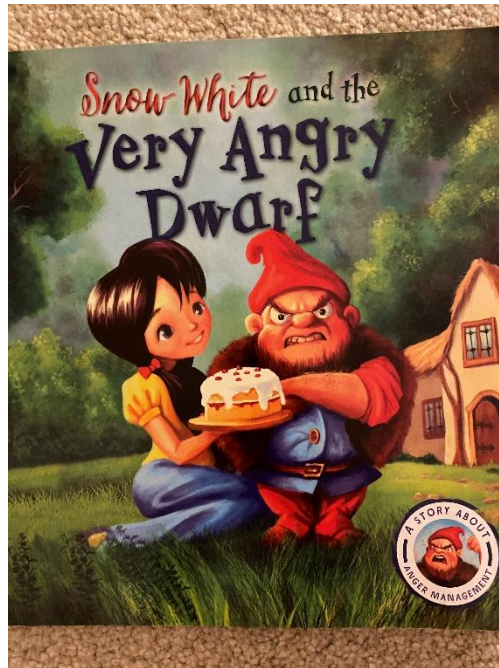

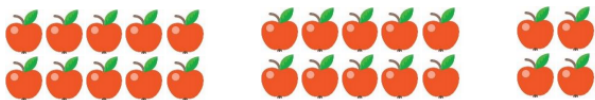

How many chillies do they each get?



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

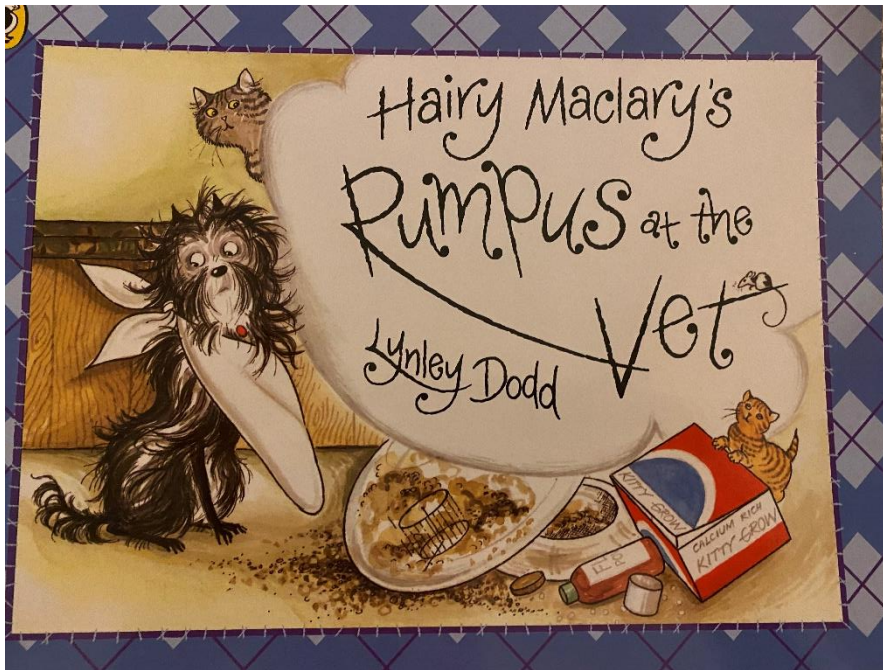

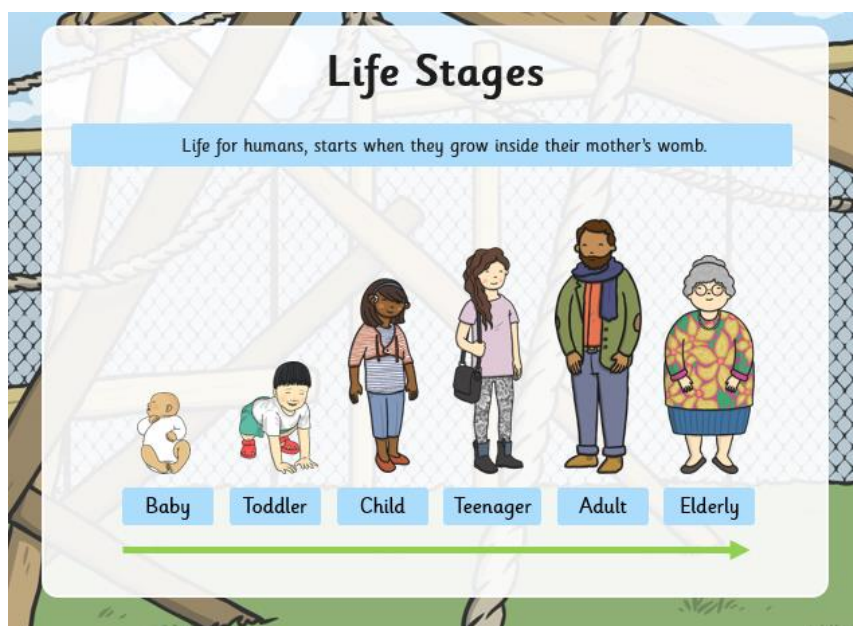
