<u>Phonics</u>

These video links will appear daily as it is important we recap every day.

After watching the videos, I would like you to write some tricky words and tell your family a sentence using the tricky words.

If parents could then write some words including pin, pat, sat, cat, mat, tip, tap and ask the child to read the words alongside them by sounding out each phoneme one at a time.

<u>Activities</u>

Here are some other activities for you to have a go at:

- Read a phonics book on oxford owl or you can read your own phonics book at home if you have one. Remember to keep practicing so you become fluent with reading. <u>Free eBook library | Oxford Owl from Oxford</u> <u>University Press.</u>
- Draw a picture of your family remember how to draw each body part and then see if you can write each person's name underneath.
- Think of different ways to make 5. You could collect 5 objects from your house and put them into 2 groups. I collected 5 pencils and had a group with 2 pencils and a group with 3 pencils making 5 pencils all together.
