<u>Task 2:</u> Two circles in your books, separate the words into pronouns and not pronouns


Task 3: Write out the 4 sentences and underline pronouns


<u>Task 4:</u> Replacing nouns, write out the 4 sentences and replace the nouns with pronouns.


Task 5: Avoid the repetition

For reading this afternoon I would like you to read a book to an adult.

Before you start reading your book, can you look at the front cover and **<u>predict</u>** what you think might happen. Who are the characters? What are their names? What might be a problem in the book?

Whilst reading, please can your adult select some words from your text and ask you to <u>clarify</u> these words. What do they mean? Why are they used?

At the end of your reading session, I would like you to <u>summarise</u> what has happened. What did you learn? What did you not expect?

In DT, we will be continuing our research into mineshafts. It was great to see all your creative ideas last week and you all designed some interesting, functional shafts.

In today's session I want you to explore mechanical systems. A mechanism is used in a mineshaft to turn and bring up the materials that are collected from the mine.

<u>Task</u>

Draw a gear and label it. How does it work? How will we use a cog in our mineshaft? How does it pull up the materials? Why was this useful in mining?
