Today, practise the letter 'p'. Remember it is a fall letter so it needs to go under the line. Make sure your letter are not too big. Watch the clip to show you how...



It can name a person, place or thing.








Quiz Time:




Addition:


Today, let's try using the counting on method.

Remember when you add you need to count 2 groups to find out how many there are altogether.






Complete the addition calculations by counting on.


