Healthy Snack and Packed Lunches

Please can we remind everyone to send in healthy snacks and packed lunches for children. It is vital that children are eating nutritious snacks and packed lunches at school. This will help children to stay fit and healthy; focus in lessons and thrive socially and emotionally. May we also remind you that we are a nut- free school. If you would like any further advice or ideas for healthy packed lunches, please do not hesitate to contact the school. If your child has a school lunch, please make payments through ParentPay (not School Grid). Meals cost £2.30 per day or £11.50 per week.

Thank you for your patience with the new school meal system, we have encountered a few problems, the two companies are now working together to rectify this.

We have noticed a few children bringing juice into school for the classroom. Having enough to drink is a key factor to improving the performance and behaviour of children at school. Water is one of the best fluids to have. It has none of the health problems associated with drinks containing sugar, additives, sweeteners, acids or caffeine. Whilst we understand that juice often tastes nicer, we know that the constant drinking of juice throughout the day is one of the biggest causes of plaque and tooth decay. Juice is only allowed with packed lunches, at lunchtime. Juice should not be used to fill our water bottles.

School Uniform

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It has been wonderful seeing all of the children looking really smart in their school uniform. From now on we are asking parents to order school uniform

Please make sure you return your child's Flu vaccine consent form by Wednesday 19th September am to ensure they are collected by the school nursing team. Forms after this will not be accepted.


Attendance


Families that take holidays in term time, for whatever reason, have a significant impact on their child's attendance and therefore on achievement. We need your support to reverse this.

We all have a legal duty to ensure our children will reach their full potential by attending school if they are able. All the evidence clearly shows that pupils with excellent attendance achieve better at school. Just a gentle reminder that the school gates open at 8.30am for children to come into school, but they close at 8.45am. We understand some children are coming in late which impacts significantly on their education, as we utilise very second of the day for learning.

If you are having problems with getting your child to attend for reasons other than a holiday, please speak to me as soon as possible so that we can work together to resolve this.



Holidays in Term Time and Unauthorised Absences



As a reminder, please see below holidays for the Academic Year 2023/2024. Holidays should only be booked within these dates. No holidays will be authorised outside of these dates unless they meet the special circumstance criteria. If you are intending to take holidays during term time please make sure you complete a holiday form so we know where your child is. This is imperative to ensure our safeguarding procedures are followed.

Reception Intake 2024

If you have a child that is due to start school next September (born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020) the on-line application system will open on 17th November 2023 (www.redcarcleveland.gov.uk/schools-and-education/school-admissions/primary-school-admissions). Applications should be made by the 15th January 2024. You should apply to the council where you reside (pay your council tax). Please spread the word amongst the community for parents who have children of school age next year. Any queries please contact the Office.
