English

In English we will be looking at the narrative "Ted and his time traveling toilet. Roman rewind" and writing pat of the story. We will focus on different parts of grammar to make our story interesting and funny! We will also write a non-chronological report on the Romans (linked to History).

We will then rewrite part of "The Miraculous journey of Edward Tulan before finishing off with a comparative report of two countries (linked to geography).



DIE

In maths the children will revisiting column addition and subtraction. We will then move onto numbers to 10.000 and perimeter. Practicing our times tables will be a daily



Jeography

In geography we are looking at Mediterranean countries and how they differ form England. We will look at a globe and how longitude and latitude can be used to locate places. We will also look at 8 points of a compass.



DIG

In art we will be looking at the work of Vincent Van Gogh. The children will be drawing with pens, pencils and coloured pencils, using lines and tones of colours to portray mood.

In PE sessions the children will participate in invasion games, dance, gymnastics and net Games. A reminder that PE kit is a plain white tshirt and black shorts.



In History we will be looking at Ancient Rome and the prominent people at this time: Julius Caesar and Boudica. We will be researching how Britain benefited from the Roman army invasion.

Reading



The books the children will be reading this term are: Ted and his time travelling toilet. Roman rewind - When Ted's toilet turns into a time machine, he's hurled into the heart of the Roman Empire! Gladiators, emperors, and epic

The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulan - A selfish toy rabbit gets lost and goes on a journey through many hands, learning how to love along the way

PSHCE

In PSHE we will be looking at "Being me in my World" and how we can become a good school citizen and a class "team" member.

We will celebrate our differences and learn how we can support someone who is bullied.

Science

MICH

In science we are looking at the digestive system and howfood travels through our bodies. We will look at food chains and also explore our teeth and the uses of the different teeth.

We will look at how living things can be grouped in a variety of ways how classification keys can help to group, identify and name a variety of living things. Environments can change and this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.





In RE we will be looking at key events in the Buddha's story include his birth, leaving his royal life, searching for enlightenment, and teaching the Four Noble Truths and the Eightfold Path.

In Christianity we will be looking at symbols and what they represent in the Christmas story.

Music

In Music, we are excited to be welcoming Sing Education into school. They will be delivering exciting, fun filled lessons over the vear.

Computing

In computing over the term, the children will be learning general IT skills as well as using different programmes to explore film making, sound production, data handling and coding. Each child will have their own iPad in school which will allow them to work independently
